## OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY Covid - Resuming public worship

Communal acts of worship are only allowed in our Catholic Churches, **under strict guidelines of oversight, hygiene, and social distancing.**

*Assuming no changes to the current government guidance we are tentatively re-scheduling:*

### **First Holy Communion and Confirmations 2020**

Please note that at both, all the guidance already issued for the celebration of Mass will need to be applied, including the social distancing and hygiene measures, with the extra limiting factor that attendance is **limited to 30 people** including those to make their First Holy Communion/Candidates. ### **First Holy Communion 2020 - NEW DATES**

To accommodate the attendance limitations - It will be taking place in two celebrations - Saturday 3rd and Saturday 10th October 2020 both at 10am.

### **Confirmations 2020 - NEW DATES**

Will also be taking place in two celebrations - Thursday 15th and Friday 16th October both at 7pm. There will also be a rehearsal with the candidates only, on Wednesday 14th October at 7pm.

### **GUIDELINES for Mass (summary)**

**DO NOT COME TO CHURCH IF YOU OR ANYONE YOU HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH HAS ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS.**

- Please observe social distancing at all times.
- **Parishioners are required to wear face coverings/masks inside the Church.**
- Spaces are limited and will be allocated on a first come first serve basis by the stewards.
- Please **use the sanitiser** provided to clean your hands on entry to and exit from the church.
- Please don't forget to bring your **pre-filled Track and Trace card** (downloadable from our website) or provide your details to the steward at the door **BEFORE** entering the Church.

**WE STILL NEED YOUR HELP - Please contact the Parish Office if you can help to steward or clean the church after each Mass, indicating which day(s) of the week you could volunteer for** and keep an eye on the Parish website for the latest information on opening times.

**Sacrament of Reconciliation** - Confessions are taking place by appointment, currently outside (and therefore weather dependant). Please contact Fr Gregory to arrange a suitable date and time.

**Baptism/Funerals** - These can now be arranged under strict guidance of hygiene, social distance and limited attendance. Please contact Fr Gregory in the parish office to discuss.
