
**Coronavirus Level 5: STAY AT HOME**

**THE NATIONAL LOCKDOWN GUIDELINES STATE IT IS STILL PERMITTED TO ATTEND CHURCH FOR COMMUNAL SERVICE (see full document attached in our parish website). Please do note we are currently experiencing soaring number of Covid cases in our local area - avoid mixing with other households before, during and after Mass.**

**Please follow all the safety guidance to ensure we look after each other and especially the most vulnerable in our parish.**

- **You must NOT come to church if you or any member of your support bubble have any covid/cold/flu symptoms, have tested positive, are waiting for test results or have been asked to shield or self-isolate for any reason.**
- **Use the NHS covid app to scan the QR code displayed on entry or bring your track and trace card/details filled in to minimise contacts on entry.**
- **Use the sanitiser gel provided, on entry and exit.**
- **Face coverings in church are a legal requirement (unless exempt).**
- **You MUST NOT mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble before, during or after the service. Please keep as much distance as possible with other households, preferably 2m, at all times.**
- **Doors and windows will need to remain open to increase ventilation, please WRAP UP.**
- **Take especial care when leaving the church ensuring you do not crowd at the exit or congregate in the carpark.**
- **For our church to remain open, we rely on the availability of our volunteer stewards & cleaners. If you can help, please contact the parish office.**

**If you or anyone in your household is especially vulnerable to covid, we ask you to STAY HOME at this time. Links to online masses are available on the parish website.**



### Open churches vital for resilience during lockdown, says Cardinal

With the announcement of a new lockdown for England to curb the rapid spread of COVID-19, Cardinal Vincent Nichols, President of the Catholic

Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, said: "The regular practice of our faith in God is a well-established source of both personal resilience and dedicated service to those in need. Such resilience and enduring service are vital in these difficult circumstances.

"I am glad that no measures have been introduced that would obstruct or curtail this essential source of energy for the common good. Catholic parishes will continue to serve the needs of their local community.

**Lockdown Support:** The coronavirus pandemic, and its effects, mean that it is a hard time for many at present. As we enter a new period of national lockdown, we know this can be a lonely and worrying time for some of our parishioners. Please keep in touch with each other. We can also help arrange the supply of emergency food through the Hayes Community Foodbank.
