New style votive candles and stands - You may have seen the new votive candles and stands in the church. These have been supplied to us on a free trial by a company called St. Killians and are being used in Westminster Cathedral as well as many other parishes and bring a number of benefits:

- Environmentally friendly
- No more soot/smoke
- No more plastic or aluminum cups

- Self-extinguishing candles system (Once the candle comes to the end of its life it falls through a hole in the base of the glass into a water reservoir). The new candles have a longer burning time of up to 1.5 hours and will now cost 50p each candle.
